



Pre-sessional Japanese language course

Duration: Monday July 4th to Friday July 8th (five days)



A pre-sessional Japanese course will be provided at EF (Education First) in Tokyo, a few minutes' walk from our Aoyama campus, which is located on the 27th floor of a skyscraper which has a beautiful view of the Tokyo skyline.

There are six levels of Japanese classes available from introductory to upper-intermediate. No Japanese study experience is required. Placements will be based on the result of both a paper test, which will be done before your arrival, and an interview on the first day at EF.

You will also have opportunities to meet other students from over 40 countries studying at EF, and participate in their extra-curricular activities during the pre-sessional course. Some activities are free of charge, but some additional fees will be charged, such as for a ticket for a museum, depending on the nature of the activities.

- Basic course – 20 lessons of 40 minutes (total 13.3 hours) (JPY 107,880)
- General course - 26 lessons of 40 minutes (total 17.3 hours) (JPY 111,480)
- Intensive course – 32 lessons of 40 minutes (total 21.3 hours) (JPY 129,480)

The above special rates will be applied to participants on the AGU International Short Program; to secure this discount **it is essential to send your application to our office** rather than EF Tokyo.
